








3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?






5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 624 responses






6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 624 responses






8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.




9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. 624 responses




10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.
