The Students Cabinet celebrated the 75th year of India's Independence by making an Independence Day Mashup by the students of our college.

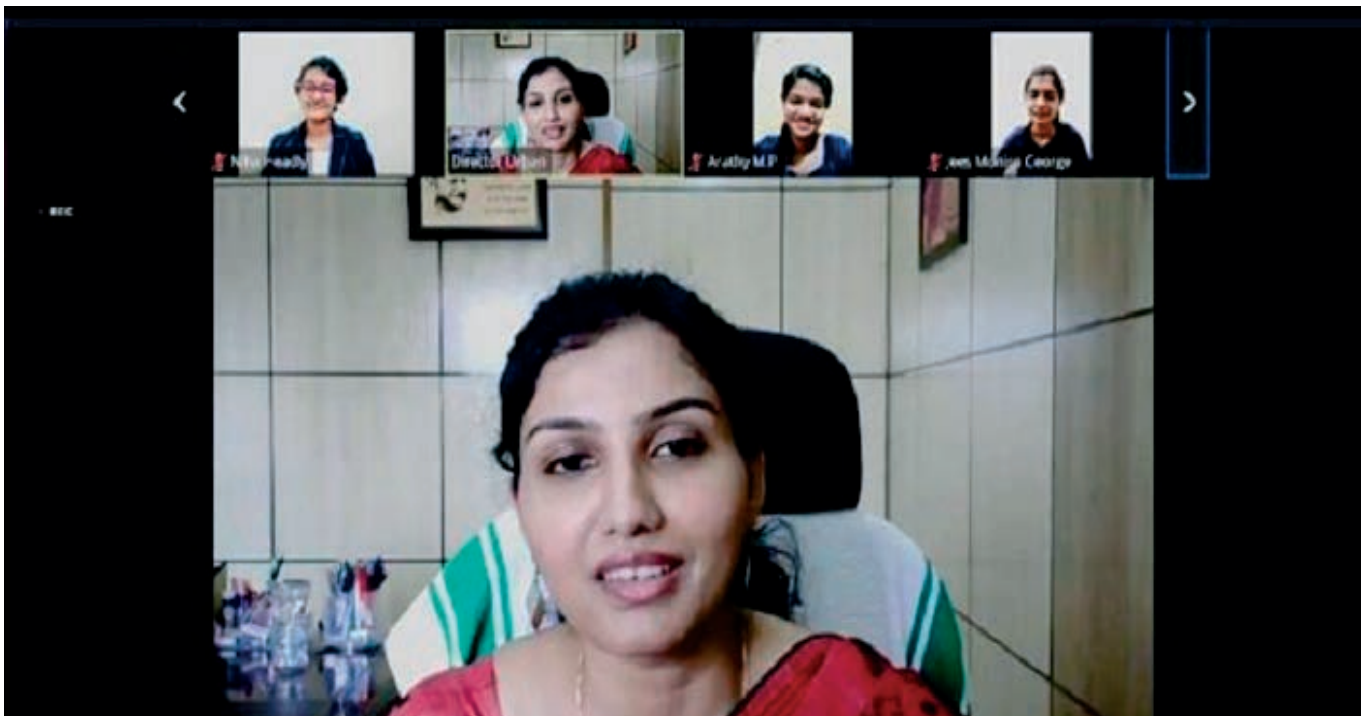
ONLINE ONAM CELEBRATION

Biju of Meenachil Bee Garden, Pala. 20 students were participated in the training programme.



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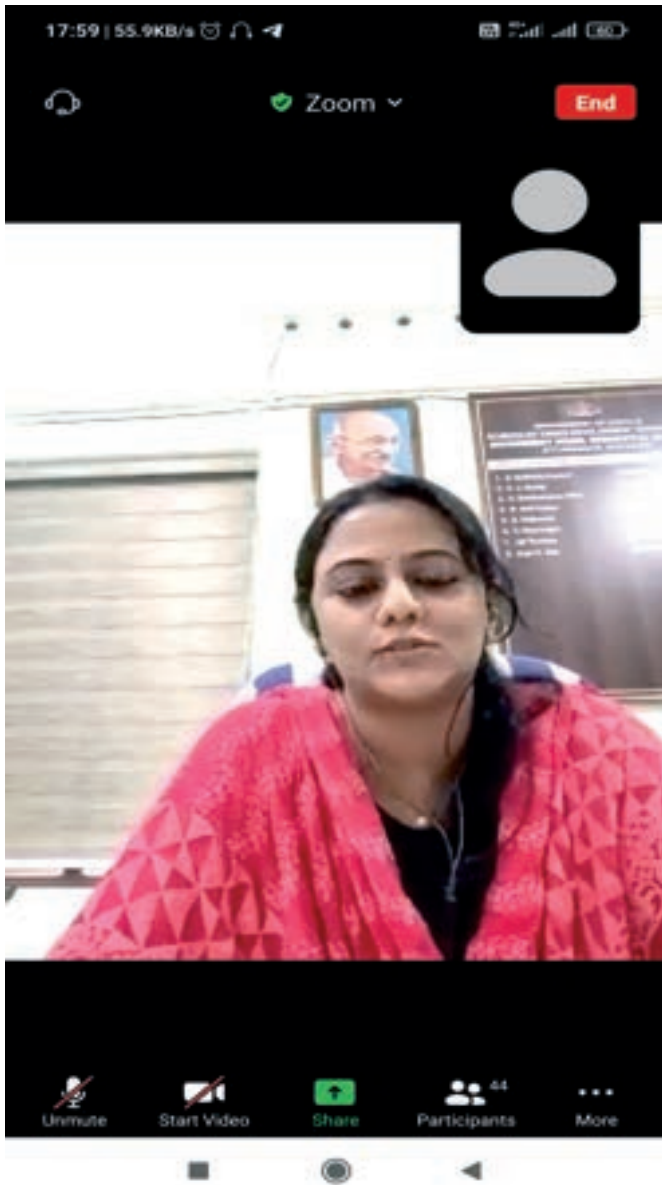
SC/ST MONITORING CELL

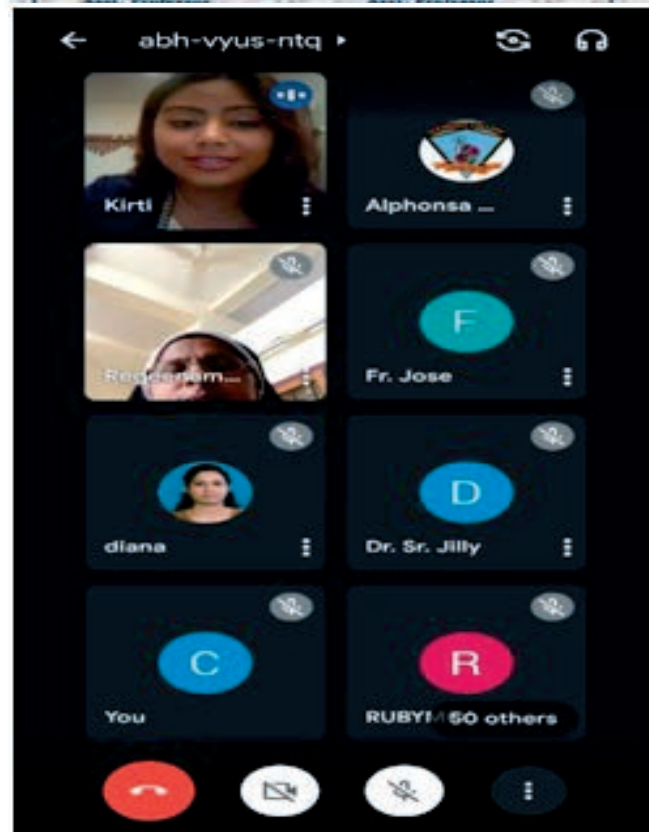
