

CHESS ACADEMY

Chess Master Academy Pala (CMAP) was established in Alphonsa College Pala as a part of its Community College Initiative. The academy was inaugurated on 22nd April 2023, commemorating Mr. T. K Joseph Tharappel, former State Chess Champion. Tharappel family organized the event. Rev. Dr. Shaji John, Principal, Alphonsa College Pala inaugurated the event. The event featured the presence of Rev. Fr. Jose Tharappel, Director of CMAP, Ms. Anila Sarath, Secretary of CMAP and Mr. Ajesh T.G, Chess Coach.

The Chess Academy serves as a hub for chess enthusiasts of all ages and skill levels to learn, practice, and compete in the game of chess. It offers a range of programs, workshops, and resources designed to foster a love for the game, develop strategic thinking skills, and nurture talent among participants. The mission of the Chess Master Academy is to promote the game of chess as a tool for intellectual development, personal growth, and community engagement. Through its programs and initiatives, the Academy aims to cultivate a culture of chess excellence, sportsmanship, and camaraderie, empowering participants to achieve their full potential both on and off the chessboard.

About fifty students took admission in the academy. At present we have twenty-three regular students. Chess coaching classes commenced on 22nd April 2023 and are regularly held on every Saturday and Sunday from 3pm to 6pm. Separate coaching classes are organized for beginners and advanced players. Classes cover fundamental chess principles, strategies, tactics, and endgame techniques, tailored to the skill level and learning goals of participants. Special training is also given focusing on Chess Opening, Middle Game and End Game. Preparatory



classes for students participating in various tournaments are also organized. The Academy provides individual and group coaching sessions with certified chess coaches and State players, offering personalized instruction, analysis, and feedback to help players improve their game. Coaches also serve as mentors, guiding players in setting goals, developing strategies, and overcoming challenges. Tri-month mini tournaments, inter-club competitions and friendly matches are organized for players to test their skills, gain experience, and compete for prizes and recognition. Computer aided training is also provided for students.

T. K. Joseph Memorial All Kerala Open Chess Tournaments

The tournament was held under three categories Under 10 Open, Under 15 Open and Senior Category, open to all. 100 cash prizes, 101 trophies and a total prize money of Rs.1.51 lakh was offered.



Chess Master Academy Pala (CMAP) also organized Kottayam District Under 19 Chess Selection Championship 2023, in association with State Chess Technical Committee, constituted by the Kerala State Sports Council. The event was held on 2nd September, 2023 at St. Thomas High School Pala. The championship was held under two categories, open category and girls category. Dr. Baiju Varghese Gurukkal, President of Kottayam District Sports Council inaugurated the championship. Participants who secured first four places were secured eligibility to compete in Under 19 State Championship. Qualified players were offered eligible

benefits as per Kerala Sports Council rules and regulations.


