St. Vincent Providence Home

St. Vincent Providence Home is 3 kms away from the college. The inmates include 70 male and female senior citizens.

Anandabhavan.

Anandabhavan is a home for the physically challenged people, situated near our adopted village. There are 20 bed ridden people and 35 other inmates in this house.

2020-2021

The NSS unit, Alphonsa College had a unique year during 2020– 2021 even though the volunteers were unable to reach out to the community physically as in the previous years. Around two hundred highly motivated volunteers worked together for their personality development and the community they live in under the supervision of two well trained programme officers. The volunteers engaged invarious skill development techniques and remained motivated to use it for the wellbeing of the community. During the lockdown days all the volunteers and two programme officers underwent Igot training for the mitigation of Covid. After the lockdown, the volunteers made cloth masks and handed it over to the concerned panchayath officials for distribution. The volunteers were given training in making soap, hand sanitizer, cloth bags, paper pens and door mats.

At the time of enrolment, the volunteers were asked to make a vegetable garden and to prepare cloth mask for free distribution. More than hundred students participated enthusiastically in it. They contributed the amount they have earned from this for various charity initiatives done by the NSS Unit.




The training of the Volunteer Force, which aims to equip every volunteer to fight against Covid 19, took place on September 19.




□ On 9 Aug 2021 an online quiz competition in relation to the International Day of World's Indigenous People was conducted. The volunteers from the department of Botany led this programme.










☐ In connection with the World Earth Day the volunteers organized an online photography competition on the theme "Nature = Hope". The students responded positively and so many entries on the theme were received.


The volunteers from English department conducted a treasure hunt called CONUNDRUM as part of their weekly program on 26th September.



The unit adopted a student of 50+ age, who was struggling to earn a livelihood along with her studies. She resumed her studies after a gap of so many years because of her passion for studies. She is a single mother of two children, one doing B.Tech and the other +2. The volunteers decided to collect ten rupees per month for her so that they can contribute 4000 towards her daily expenses. In addition the unit contributed Rs. 75,000/- in different installments for her during the last two years. She was assisted to start a Janaseva Kendram by the time she complete her graduation from our college. The Kendra is to start functioning by 15 July 2021 after her final year BA Exams.









The unit raised funds for the charity initiatives from the activities like exhibitions and food fest conducted in the previous years as well as from the vegetable gardens maintained by the volunteers.

The volunteers collected money for the house renovation of a student of our college and as a result of the joint effort a kitchen, a room and toilet are built.








Day 3 - 22/12/2020




