

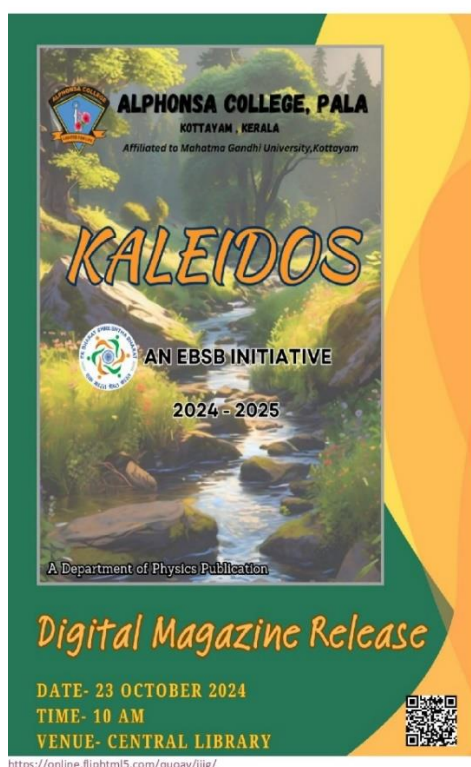

Digital magazine KALEIDOS - Department of Physics

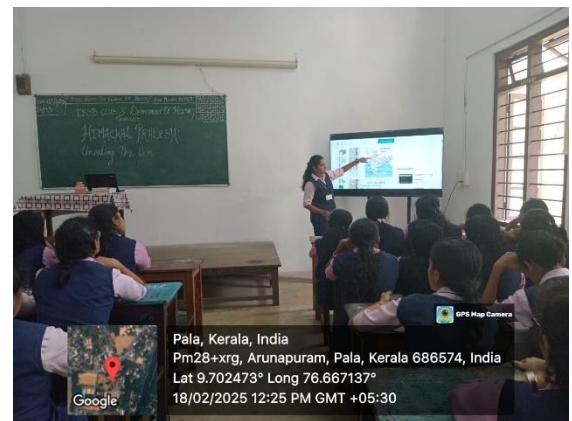
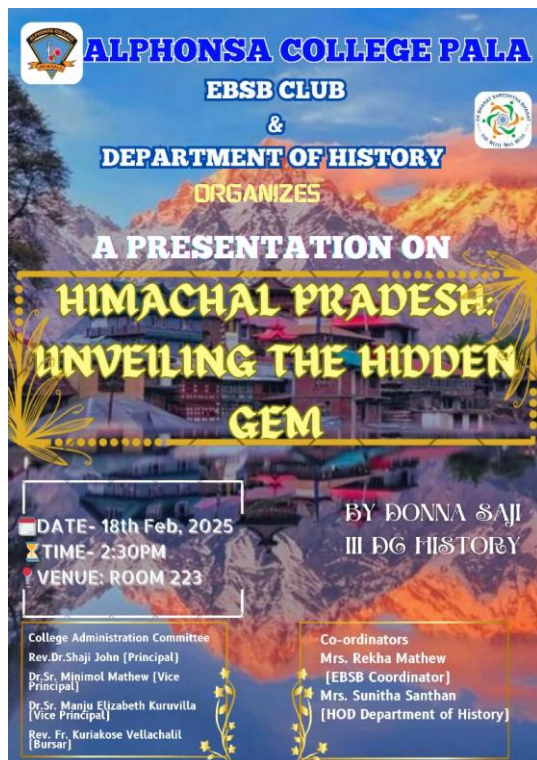
