The College has constructed ramps, railings, accessible washrooms and Braille-enabled sign boards for differently abled persons. The cell organises activities aimed to initiate conversations on various barriers confronting students with disabilities and other forms of social exclusion, build empathy, and to motivate them to overcome societal barriers.

The main objective of the Equal Opportunity Cell is to help and empower persons with disabilities, and students to participate fully in the academic, intellectual, social, and cultural life of College on an equal basis. To enhance confidence, social interaction, and visibility of their talents.

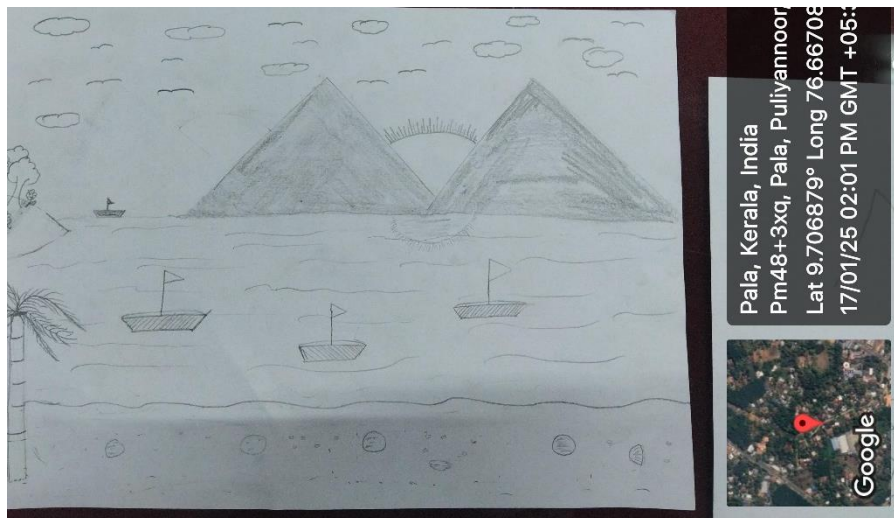
To create an enabling environment that recognizes their abilities and contributions.

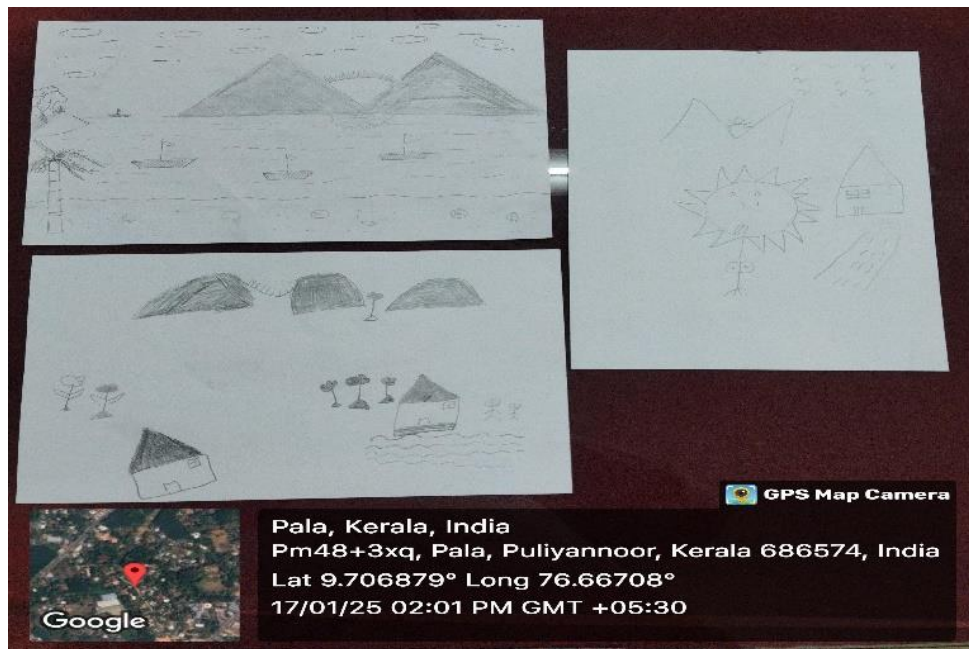
